### **Health Care Needs Policy**

<b>Purpose</b>	To ensure that Darley Primary School provides appropriate support to students with health care needs
<b>Objective</b>	To explain to Darley Primary School parents, carers, staff and students the processes and procedures in place to support students with health care needs at school.
<b>Scope</b>	This policy applies to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• all staff, including casual relief staff and volunteers</li><li>• all students who have been diagnosed with a health care need that may require support, monitoring or medication at school.</li></ul>
<b>Policy</b>	<p>This policy should be read with Darley Primary School's First Aid, Administration of Medication, Anaphylaxis and Asthma policies.</p> <p><b>Student health support planning</b></p> <p>In order to provide appropriate support to students at Darley Primary School who may need medical care or assistance, a Student Health Support Plan will be prepared by the Leading Teacher – Inclusion, Wellbeing &amp; Engagement in consultation with the student, their parents, carers and treating medical practitioners.</p> <p>Student Health Support plans help our school to assist students with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• routine health care support needs, such as supervision or provision of medication</li><li>• personal care support needs, such as assistance with personal hygiene, continence care, eating and drinking, transfers and positioning, and use of health-related equipment</li><li>• emergency care needs, such as predictable emergency first aid associated with asthma, seizure or diabetes management.</li></ul> <p>Note: Template health planning forms are available here: <a href="https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/health-care-needs/resources">https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/health-care-needs/resources</a></p> <p>Students with complex medical care needs, for example, tracheostomy care, seizure management or tube feeding, must have a Student Health Support Plan which provides for appropriate staff to undertake specific training to meet the student's particular needs.</p> <p>At enrolment or when a health care need is identified, parents/carers should provide accurate information about the student's condition or health care needs, ideally documented by the student's treating medical/health care practitioner on a Medical Advice Form (or relevant equivalent) Note: Template health planning forms are available here: <a href="https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/health-care-needs/resources">https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/health-care-needs/resources</a></p> <p>Darley Primary School may invite parents and carers to attend a Student Support Group meeting to discuss the contents of a student's Health Support Plan and assistance that the student may need at school or during school activities.</p> <p>Where necessary, Darley Primary School may also request consent from parents and carers to consult with a student's medical practitioners, to assist in preparing the plan and ensure that appropriate school staff understand the student's needs. Consultation with the student's medical practitioner will not occur without parent/carer consent unless required or authorised by law.</p> <p>Student Health Support Plans will be reviewed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• when updated information is received from the student's medical practitioner</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• when the school, student or parents and carers have concerns with the support being provided to the student</li> <li>• if there are changes to the support being provided to the student, or</li> <li>• on an annual basis.</li> </ul> <p><b>Management of confidential medical information</b></p> <p>Confidential medical information provided to Darley Primary School to support a student will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• recorded on the student's file</li> <li>• shared with all relevant staff so that they are able to properly support students diagnosed with medical conditions and respond appropriately if necessary.</li> </ul>
<b>Communication</b>	<p>This policy will be communicated to our school community in the following ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Included in staff induction processes and staff training</li> <li>• Available publicly on our school's website</li> <li>• Included in staff handbook/manual</li> <li>• Discussed at staff briefings/meetings as required</li> <li>• Included in transition and enrolment packs</li> <li>• Discussed at parent information nights/sessions</li> <li>• Reminders in our school newsletter</li> <li>• Hard copy available from school administration upon request</li> </ul>
