At Darley Kidz Club we provide a quality service to ensure that the children's physical, emotional and social needs are met in a safe, caring and supportive environment.

Our leadership team and educators understand and comply with the Child Safe Standards and Principles to create, provide and maintain a child safe organisation. As a dedicated team we work collaboratively to share our knowledge and expertise. We empower children to make choices, promote peer relationships, and provoke thoughts and imagination through play and the arts. We recognise that ongoing communication and collaboration between families, educators, management, leadership and the wider community will form positive relationships and strong partnerships.

At Darley Kidz Club we support all children to feel a sense of belonging. We acknowledge and value our traditional owners, and promote cultural safety for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. We foster inclusion so that all children have equitable access to resources and participation, and can value differences.

Our vision is to create and sustain a collaborative learning community that provides quality care for all children. Our practices are guided by the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework and the My Time, Our Place Framework for School Age Care in Australia, the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, and the Early Childhood Australia Code of Ethics.

We provide play, learning and leisure opportunities that are meaningful to children and support their wellbeing and development. Through observation and listening, we question and suggest new possibilities and encourage children to share and explore. We believe that all children are confident, competent and resourceful learners who are capable of constructing their knowledge of the world around them. We encourage sustainable practices and opportunities for children to engage in gardening, and other activities to promote social responsible and respect for the environment.

We support families in their parenting role and share information about their child's participation in the program and aspects of the wellbeing, development and learning. We also encourage our families to be active participants within our Service through sharing their suggestions, ideas, knowledge and cultures.
