Please find the fee schedule for *Year Four* attached. Please log in to Compass and set up a payment plan or pay in full. If you would prefer to use your school credit or another form of payment please print out the form from Compass and bring into the office. Alternatively you can print this form out and return it to school with your payment. We require a deposit or payment plan by *Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2020* so the school can prepare accordingly.

*Darley Primary School* makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

*Parent contribution requests will be made in line with the principles of Educational value; Access, Equity and Inclusion; Affordability; Engagement and Support; Respect and Confidentiality; Transparency and Accountability.*

*Parents contributions will be requested to assist the school in providing an enhanced teaching and learning program for every student in line with school priorities.*

### Financial Support for Families
